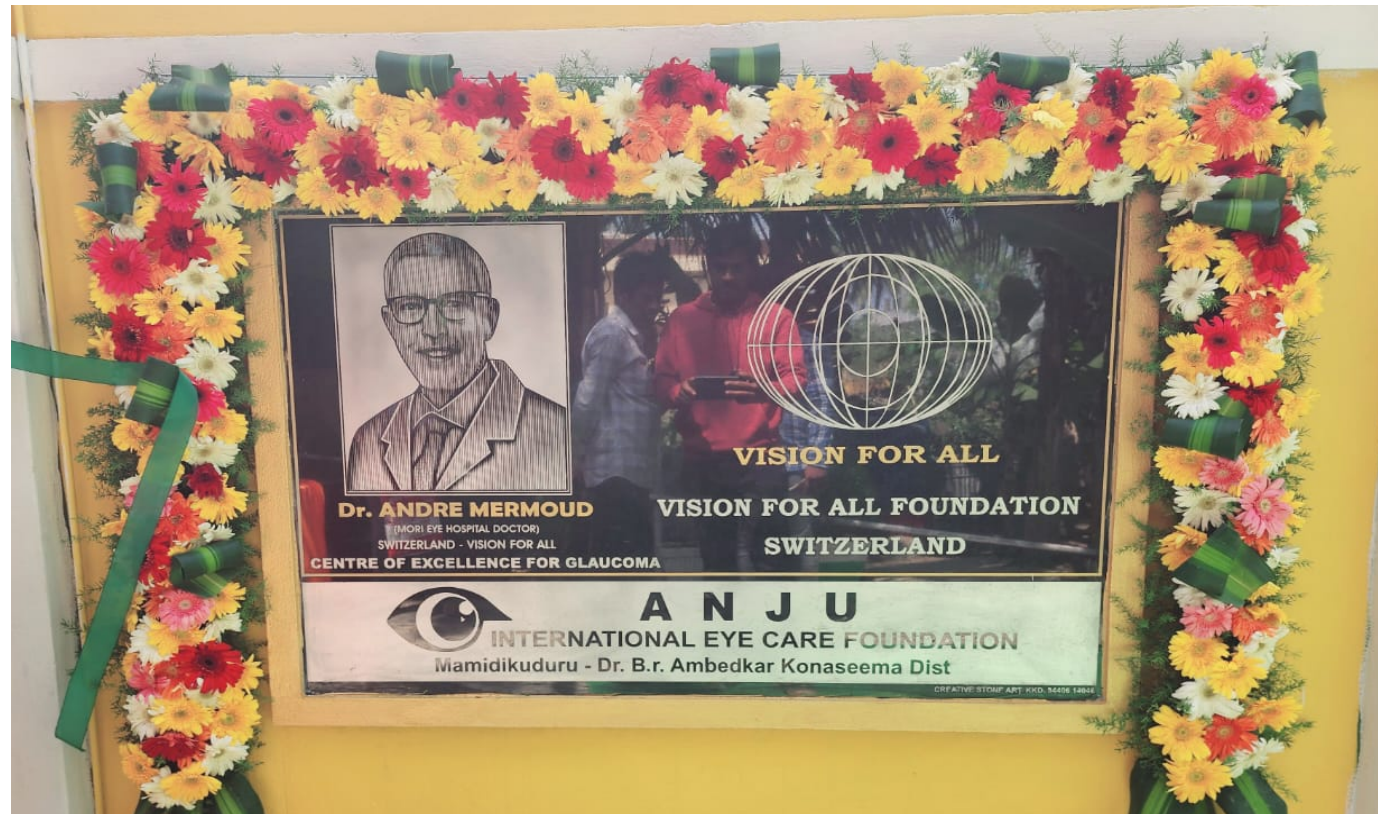

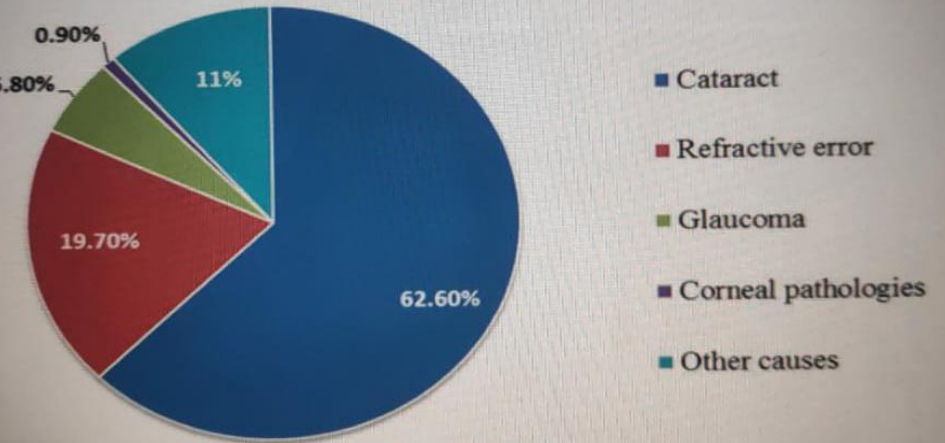
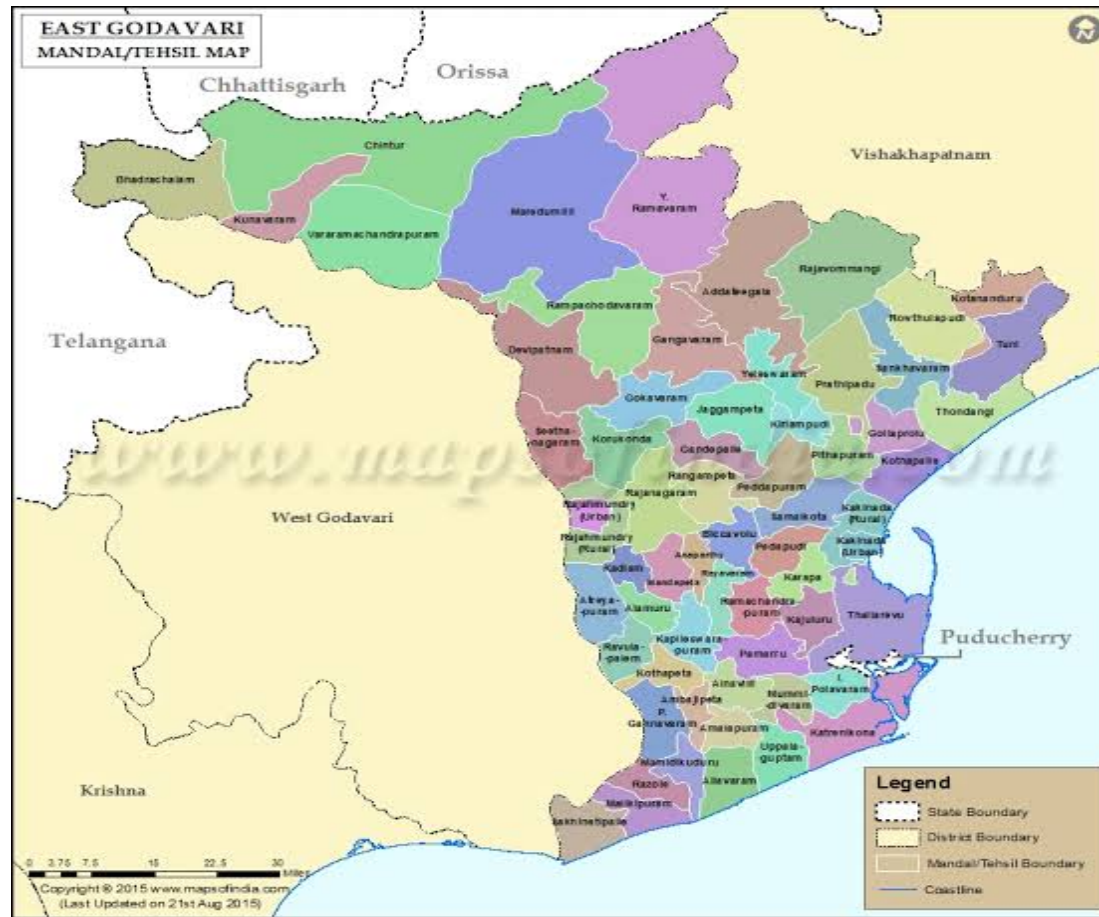

Mamidikuduru - Konaseema

- Mamidikuduru to Mori distance is 22 KM
- From Amalapuram the distance is 9 KM
- A total population of Mamidikuduru 70,369 according to 2011 Census
- Literacy rate is 82%
- Previously there was a General Hospital – People's Hospital (40+ Yrs)

Anju Foundation took lease for 10 yrs & Renovation was done

Location & Demographics of Eye Problems



Main Causes of Blindness in these population areas are as follows:

A	Cataract	62.6%
B	Refractive Error	19.7%
C	Corneal Blindness	0.90%
D	Glaucoma	5.80%
E	Surgical Complication	1.20%
F	Posterior Capsular Opacification	0.90%
G	Posterior Segment Disorder	4.70%
H	Others	4.19%

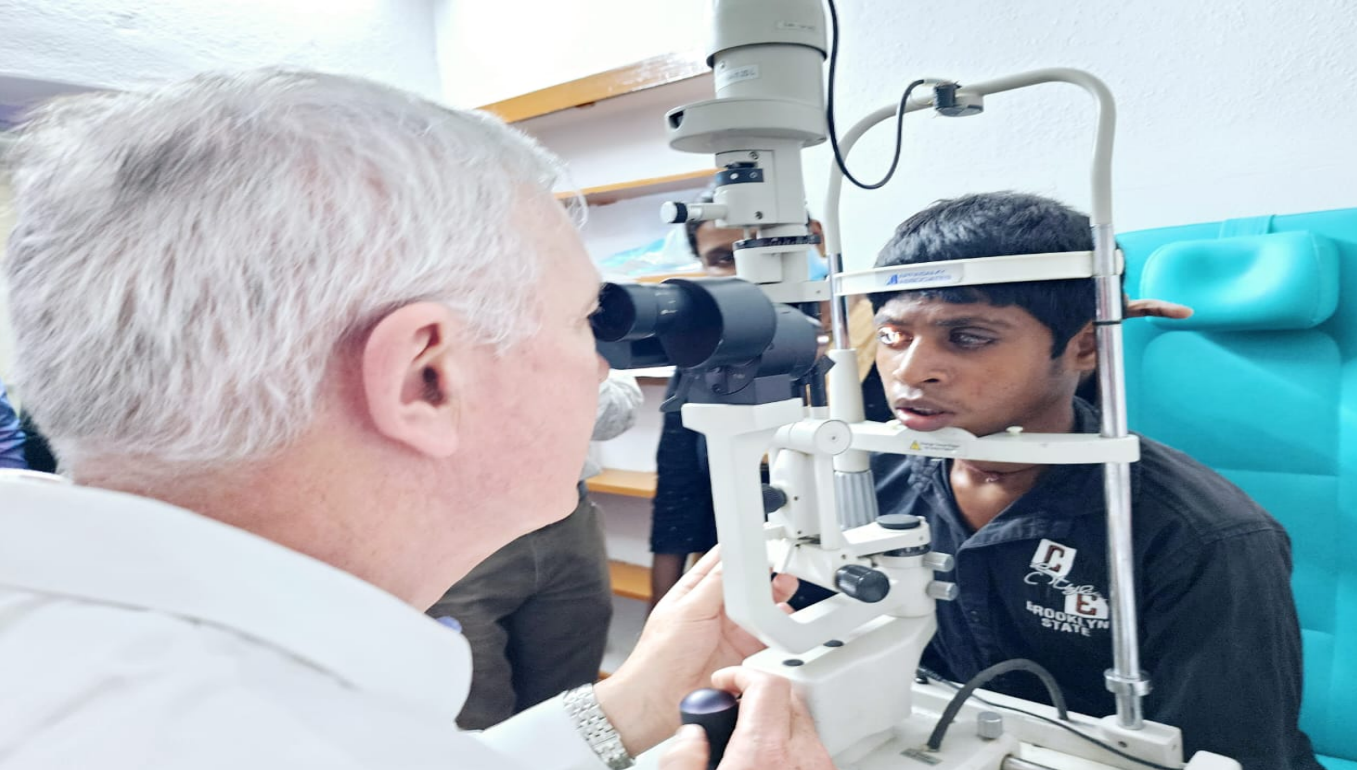

Budget Requirements for Surgeries (Free for patients)

- CATARACT SURGERIES -- $100 \times 4000 = 4,00,000$ INR 4387.89 CHF
- GLAUCOMA SURGERIES - $20 \times 7000 = 1,40,000$ INR 1535.76 CHF
- PTERYGIUM Surgerie -- $15 \times 6000 = 90,000$ INR 987.28 CHF

- TOTAL PER MONTH = 6,30,000 INR 6910.93 CHF
- ANNUAL TOTAL = 75,60,000 INR 82931.16 CHF

Capital spent by-Anju Foundation Mamidikuduru

- Rental Advance : =INR 4,50,000
- Monthly Rent : 15 Months *Rs.45,000/- = INR 6,75,000
- Hospital Renovation and Furniture: = INR 25,00,000
 - ✓ Modular Operation Theatre(including floor, walls, ceiling) : INR 10,00,000
 - ✓ Front Elevation : INR. 2,00,000
 - ✓ Patient Rooms Flooring and walls painting : INR 3,00,000
 - ✓ Construction of Patient Toilets : INR 2,00,000
 - ✓ Patient waiting area shed construction : INR 1,50,000
 - ✓ Consultation and Vision Rooms Flooring and wall painting : INR 2,50,000
 - ✓ Furniture, Slit Lamp, Chair Units, Vision Charts, Air Conditions : INR 4,00,000
- Monthly Hospital Maintenance (Electricity , Phones , Stationary etc)-
15 Months* INR 20,000 = INR 3,00,000
- Outreach Camp Expenses(Including Campaigning, Camp Stationary, Vehicle fuel , Staff food etc)-
Total Camps 55 in 15 Months : **55*** INR 15,000 = INR 8,25,000
